Recovery RX was founded by Chad Belger in late 2019, with the goal of bringing addicts in recovery together with free workouts. Chad found that a big part of him reaching sobriety was with the time and tribe he found in the gym. Workouts remain the backbone of what we do.

Recovery RX, through donations, also helps those who are ready to take steps to getting sober by helping cover some of the costs of treatment, and transitional housing.

Our ultimate goal was to open our own affordable recovery living homes for men and women coming out of treatment for addiction. Chad found his stay in transitional housing to be the key to his maintaining sobriety when entering back into the normal rhythms of life.

## ABOUT OUR FOUNDER

I'm Chad and I've been an alcoholic since I was 13 years old. I've spent the majority of my life not caring if I lived or died. One night in January 2018, I had a bottle of pills in my hand and enough booze already in my system to make sure that I wouldn't wake up the next day. At that moment, when I was as low as I had ever been, sick of suffering and being miserable, my Higher Power changed my heart. At that moment, I decided to try one more time to get sober. I was finally desperate and surrendered to the fact that I was a hopeless alcoholic. I went to treatment, found a support group, and another man I admire, to help me through the process.

Since that day, I've dedicated myself to being my absolute best and helping other men and women find the peace that I have found. I'm finally the man, husband, coach, and firefighter that I longed to be my entire adult life.

- Residents will not be allowed to use drugs or drink alcohol. Any residents that do not comply with these guidelines will be discharged from the home and referred back to inpatient treatment.



To be eligible for living in our home, you must have just recently completed an inpatient program.
